There are several offices involved in receiving your materials -- Notably, **UW Office of Study Abroad**, **UW Office of** [International] Admissions, and the **UW Department of Economics**. There are a few items that need to be completed to ensure your pathway to UW is successful. The overall process is outlined <u>here</u>.

Passport Scan & Preferred Email Address

This item I need from you now, or as soon as possible. Please scan of the 'information page' of your passport, and email this file to <u>econadv@uw.edu</u>, along with your preferred email address.

UW Study Abroad Online Application

Following the step above, the UW Office of Study Abroad will create a <u>Study Abroad Online Application</u> for you. This Online Application will request additional information/documents from you. You will receive notification of this Online Application via email. **The deadline to complete the Online Application is March 1**st (for students starting Autumn Quarter) or August 1st (for students starting Winter or Spring Quarters). The Online Application Fee will be paid for by the UW Department of Economics, as a courtesy to you and your home institution.

Information Packet from UW International Admissions

Once your Online Application is completed and approved by UW Study Abroad and UW International Admissions, I will receive your admissions information packet, typically about 8 weeks after your Study Abroad Online Application is completed. This packet will contain:

- Acceptance Letter to UW
- DS-2019 (to secure J-1 visa)
- Instructions on how to create a UW Account
- J-1 Visa Information
- Checklist of J-1 Exchange Students

This packet will be forwarded to your exchange coordinator, mainly because the DS-2019 cannot be sent electronically.
