According to the timeline listed here, **the UW International Programs & Exchanges deadline for application materials is March 1st (for Autumn Quarter) or August 1st (for Winter or Spring Quarter)**. This allows time for coordinators, like me, to review them for completion before forwarding them to UW Admissions. You are welcome to send your applications to me directly, or follow whatever instructions your program/exchange adviser, has provided for you. I am able to forward them to UW IPE on your behalf.
